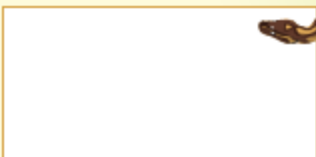
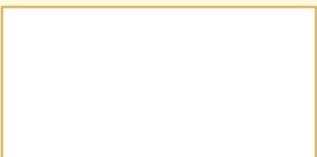
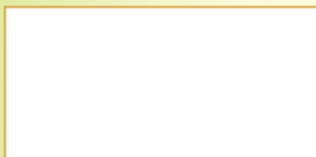
Mammals:

Mammals have fur or hair. Their blood is warm. The babies are born alive. Babies drink their mother's milk.



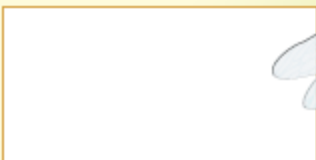
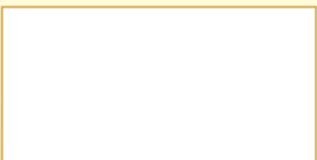
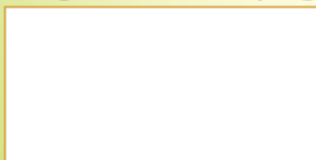
Reptiles:

Reptiles live in water and on land. They lay their eggs on land. Reptiles have scales and a dry skin.



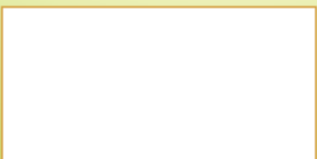
Insects:
